### **Statement of Services for Children with Hearing Impairment**

Hearing itinerant services may be requested to address (but not limited to) the following:

- a) Sensory-neural loss of hearing in conjunction with described academic difficulties and/or speech and language delays.
- b) Audiological monitoring of a progressive sensory-neural hearing impairment in conjunction with an audiologist.
- c) Longstanding conductive or fluctuating hearing impairment which has not responded to medical intervention.
- d) Longstanding medically documented fluctuating hearing loss.
- e) Unilateral hearing impairment which is contributing to a reduction in educational progress in the classroom.
- g) A recommendation for monitoring of a hearing impairment by a physician or an audiologist (including ABR results).
- h) Preschool children who are unable to complete a school screening test but who may present a combination of the following symptoms:
  1. Lack of attention or concentration.
  2. Significant speech and language delays, unintelligible speech.
  3. Failure to understand when not facing the speaker.
  4. Inability to comprehend verbal instructions.
